1. The online classroom.

To turn off the chime when people enter the room, go to Edit->Preferences->General->Audible Notifications and un-enable "participant joined" and "participant left."

You can't chat until I enable it.

I can see all private chats.

Please do not turn on video of yourself.

You cannot talk to the class. If you need to ask a question, type it in the chat.

Play with the emoticons, if you'd like.

Please don't type in all caps. It's too hard to read.

Please keep comments in the chat focused to what we are doing in class.

Please don't interrupt. I will ask for questions; please post questions then. Correcting a math error does not constitute interrupting. If you have questions about due dates or policies, ask them before or after class.

Use your name when you log in. First name, Last name. No Lady Gaga or Justin Bieber, please.

If you lose audio or video, log out and log back in. If that doesn't help, you may have to watch the video of the session and do the alternate.

2. Poppers
