Aunt Sarah and the Farm



Aunt Sarah wants to help her nephew Jack. However, she does not want to simply give him money. Instead she will provide him with a 10×10 plot of land provided he keeps it fenced. At the end of the year she will reduce the width by 1 and increase the length so that in the second year he will have an 11×9 plot. This will be done each year until there is nothing left but a fence (i.e., 20×0). This way it will be up to Jack to work hard and make the most of this opportunity.

Help Jack explore what to expect over the next 10 years. As a start, for each year find:

- 1. How much land will Jack lose from the preceding year?
- 2. How much land will Jack lose from the first year?
- 3. How will the shape of his farm change over time?
- 4. How many feet of fencing will it take to fence it in?
